

The 2022 Clara Johnson Award

for women's literature is open to all women-authored (born or identified) literature, including fiction and non-fiction, creative non-fiction, and memoir published during the 2021 calendar year.

Named in honor of Clara Johnson, an original editor at Jane's Stories Anthologies, this award was established by Jane's Stories Press Foundation in 2018 to honor women-authored literature that captures the essence of Johnson in being "groundbreaking, purposeful, bold, excellent, and challenging to social constructs."

Jane's Stories Press Foundation is an international, nonprofit organization that nurtures emerging and established women writers and encourages the inclusion of women's voices in all their diversity in the publishing industry. Since 2001, JSPF has offered literary resources, education, and friendship for women.
